


REMINDER-WASTEWATER CALCULATIONS




MEET YOUR NEW BOARD MEMBERS

<u>DOÑA ANA VILLAGE LIFT STATION AND FORCEMAIN</u>

Spartan Construction has completed the work for the Doña Ana Village Lift Station and Forcemain. This system was originally built by Doña Ana County in 1997 and was transferred over to Doña Ana MDWCA in July 2017. This project consisted of upgrading the lift station on Pedro Madrid, which included new pumps, electrical components, and safety features. Spartan Construction also replaced the 8" forcemain down El Camino Real with a 12" forcemain that tied into the 18" main line South of Los Venados Subdivision.

Commercial agriculture means the growing of crops for food, fiber, consumption, or grazing or raising of livestock with the intent to sell the products for profit.
